How to use the Discipleship Roadmap

Have you ever thought about your spiritual journey? It is just that, a journey. It is a life-long adventure of following Jesus and striving to be more like Him every day. This Road Map has two purposes. First, it is a tool to help individuals easily recognize steps that can be taken to grow in their faith. Secondly, it is a guide for disciplemaking. Disciplemaking is one of the essential callings for every believer (core value 8). As followers, we are called to "Know Christ" and "Make Christ Known."

The Discipleship Road Map has four sections: Beginning, Understanding, Maturing, and Reproducing. Each section has milestones that indicate Spiritual growth. These are not necessarily in order; they are more like markers to track and promote growth on your life-long journey to become a reproducing follower of Jesus.

You might recognize that you are "Maturing" in one section and "Beginning" in another. Ask yourself this question: "What is the next best step in my personal growth or the person I am discipling?" Follow the road map and GO! The "Tools For Success" section has resources that will help you take your next step.

Remember, we never fully arrive on our faith journey; there is always room to grow.
